 - What search terms are they using in your search function? Do you then employ those same terms?
 - Would a microsite work better for some departments? First, get baseline data, then pilot a microsite to see if there's more traffic.

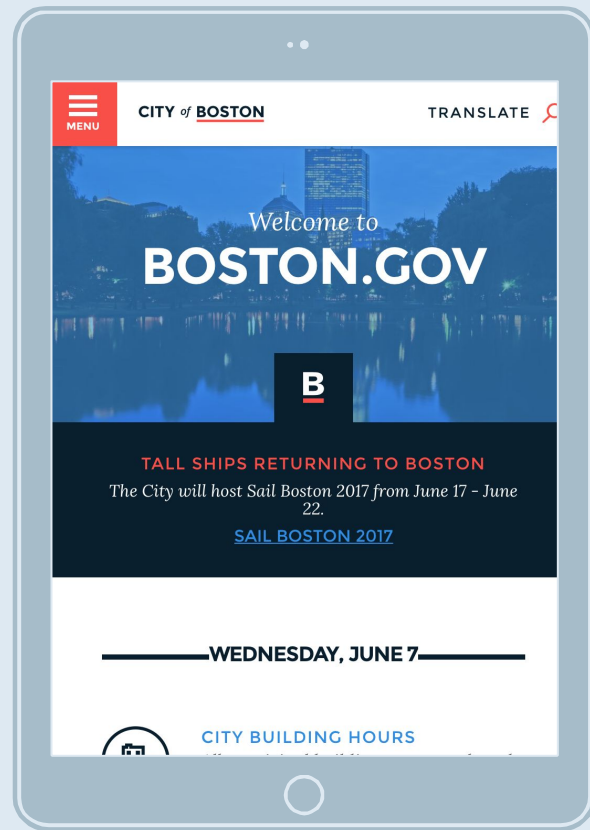
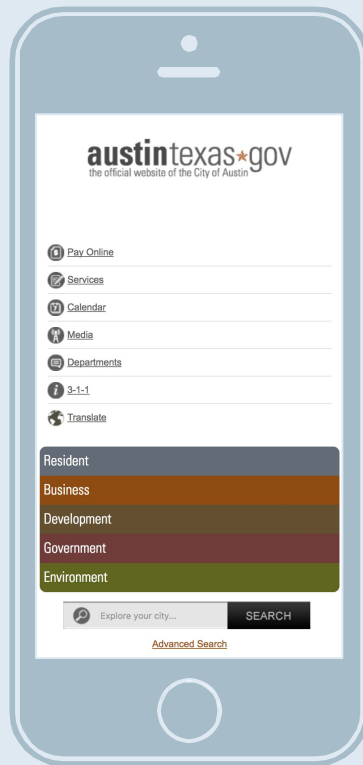

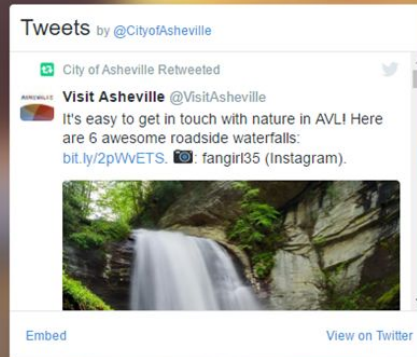
Who is listening for your city? How could a digital platform help?

- Other full-bodied engagement information to make it easier for citizens to get involved.

GOOD CONTENT

Having good content on the website (and the right amount of it) that is: relevant to your organization, useful and helpful to site visitors, and updated with the right frequency.





What are

- **Primary target keywords**
 - Water bill
 - Permits
 - Police
 - Parks & Events
 - **Secondary target keywords**
 - Pool, adopt animals, city council, public notice, etc.
 - **Meta tag keywords**
- 

metatags

snippets of text that describe a page's content; the meta tags don't appear on the page itself, but only in the page's code...



What are people searching for?



- **Meta Keywords Attribute**
A series of keywords you deem relevant to the page in question.
- **Title Tag**
This is the text you'll see at the top of your browser. Search engines view this text as the "title" of your page.
- **Meta Description Attribute**
A brief description of the page.

Fixing broken code... broken links... incorrect spellings... organizing your site map, etc.

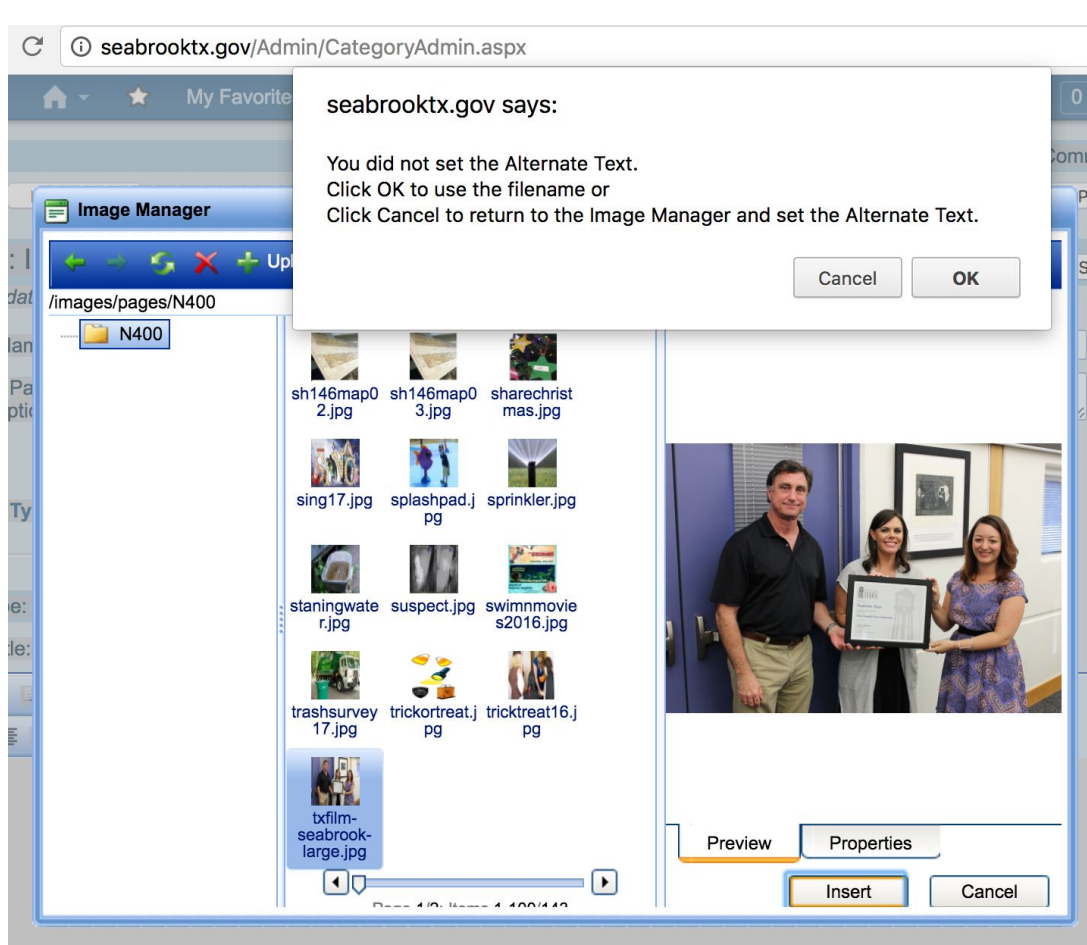

People Prefer Their Native Language

English is the most-widely spoken language... however, to effectively communicate with people, it's not enough to speak a language that they understand (especially if their understanding is limited). You must speak to them in the language their heart speaks.

Performance

Do you have a SLOW site?

47% of
consumers
expect a web
page to load in 2
seconds or less



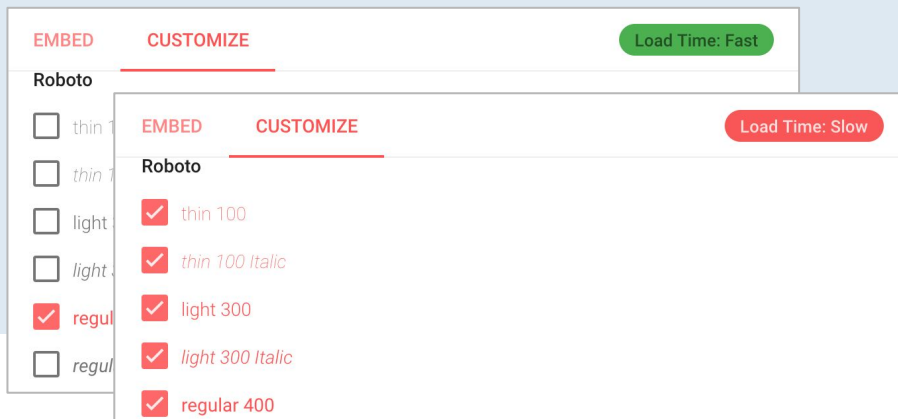
- Under 100 milliseconds is perceived as **instantaneous**
- A 100 - 300 ms **delay is perceptible**
- One second is about the **limit for the user's flow of thought** to stay uninterrupted
- After 3 seconds, 40% of **visitors will abandon your site**

- **Too many or poorly-optimized images**
Curate and optimize.
- **Embeds**
Iframes and widgets can wreak havoc.
- **Fonts**
Again, curate...or use system fonts.

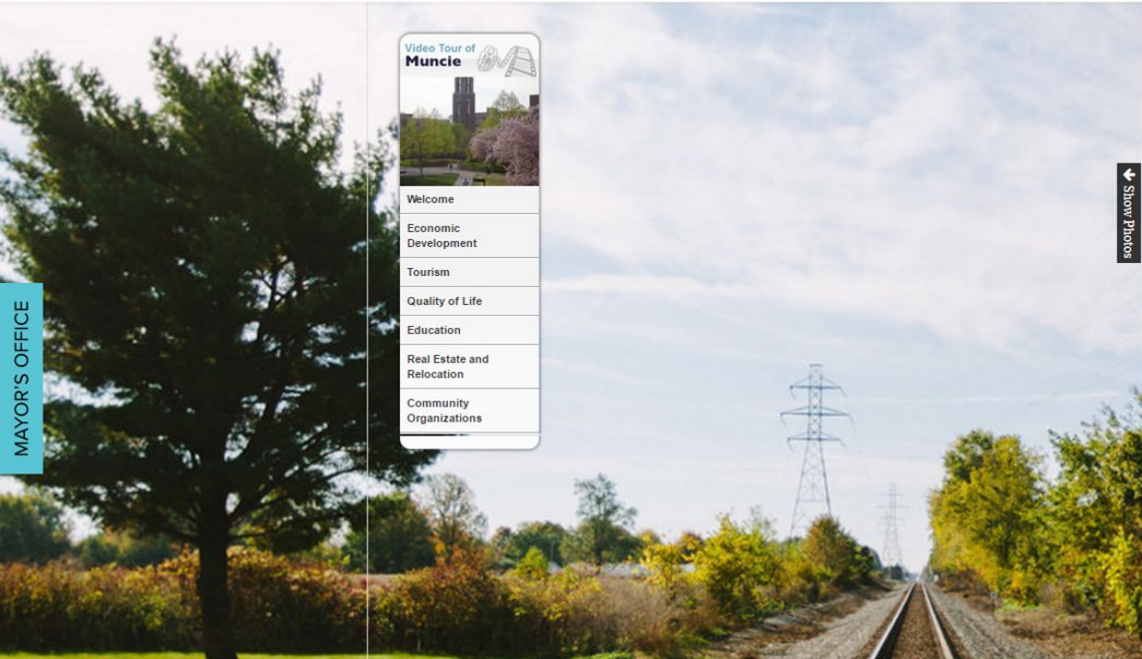

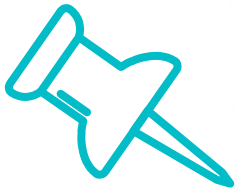

How Many Clicks

Is it easy to get to a phone
number or email address for
elected officials?



Out of 200 city websites from across the country

73 cities did not list the address for city hall on the homepage (31 were for cities with populations above 250,000).

Only 10 city sites included information on the homepage for how to contact elected officials directly; on 115 homepages, users had to click once for this information, and 75 homepages had navigation pathways forcing users to click two or more times to reach either an email address or phone number for elected officials.
